III. Students will have 6 Progress Grades (PG) and 2 Summative Grades every quarter.

- The two sightreading quiz grades are progress grades to the summative sightreading test. If you score higher on the summative sightreading test than the progress sightreading quiz, your score for both progress sightreading quiz will be changed to the higher summative sightreading test score. Sightreading Quizzes and Test will be completed in Canvas.
- The two quartet quiz grades are progress grades to the summative concert/concert evaluation. <u>If you score higher</u> on the summative concert/concert evaluation test than the progress quartet quiz, your score for both progress quartet quiz will be changed to the higher summative concert/concert evaluation test score. Quartet Quizzes will be in class.

Attendance

A grade will be given for each performance. An absence from a performance will result in a "zero" Major Grade for the six weeks in which the absence occurred. Leaving during a concert, for any reason, will result in a "85" as your performance grade. Being late to the call will result in "10" points off your performance grade.

You will always be given ample prior notice of rehearsals and concerts, and you will be expected to make arrangements with your employer to attend these rehearsals and performances. Also, many of you are involved in other LTHS and community activities that will, from time to time, conflict with our rehearsals and performances. You are expected to do all in your power to make arrangements to attend these required events. Teachers will work together so please let us know there is something to work out.

Special Circumstances

If you have extenuating circumstances and cannot attend the rehearsal or performance, you must personally submit your reason for needing to miss to the director <u>in writing prior to the rehearsal</u>. If you are absent from school the day of an after school rehearsal or performance, you must contact the director prior to our performance for the absence to be excused.

Attendance at department concerts is mandatory for all students and is not excused for birthdays, anniversaries, etc. Absences may be excused only at Director's discretion.

If you need to speak with Mr. Buntyn about special circumstances regarding yourself or your children (i.e. can't pay fees all at once, missing rehearsals/performances, questions regarding policies or activities, etc.) please contact the director.

LTHS Graduation Profile

<u>Departmental Overview</u>

The choral students at Lebanon Trail High School will learn to appreciate and perform music in varying styles, from an array of cultures, and at appropriate difficulty levels. We will present concerts and perform throughout the year. We will also be an active department socially. The elected leadership will help select and organize our social activities. Some social activities will be for all members, and some for the varsity choir....membership has its privileges!

Each student in a choir will be responsible for learning a solo and performing it individually at some point this year. You may choose to perform your solo in front of only the director, in front of the class, during one of the choral departments special concerts, or at UIL Solo and Ensemble Competition. Auditioning for All-Region Choir can count as your solo performance, but you would still be able to do one or more of the other options

We will be active participants in the Musical each year which will be produced by the Fine Arts Department and Co-Directed by Mr. Buntyn and Mr. Hollomon. The musical will be open to the entire school but the choral department needs to be well-represented in the cast. Well-represented in no way means participation in the Musical is a mandatory commitment. What it does mean is that we are the singers....we should want to sing in the show!

The Chorale Choir Officers and non-varsity leadership council (members elected by the JV choirs in the first few weeks of school) will help the director in leadership, decision making, communication, and labor. Strong leaders, who are not afraid to work, are asked to consider running for and serving on the leadership council. Election information will be forthcoming in class and on the choir website.

We will, above all else, work to make ourselves better singers and musicians. We will strive to become independent musicians who understand advanced musical concepts and who perform challenging and worthwhile choral literature.

Choir Evaluations/Auditions

Evaluations are used to determine membership in select choirs and will be based on the following criteria:

Sight-reading test 100pts.

Sight-reading Yearly Average 100pts.

Vocal Quality 100pts.

Rehearsal Participation 100pts.

Homework Grades 100pts.

Grades 5pts per 6 weeks eligible (25max)

VOLT Pop Acappela Group

Membership will be determined by an audition procedure which will be posted in advance on the choir website and the choir bulletin boards. The student will need to prepare a solo to sing A cappella. The director will choose students for call backs on the following criteria:

Vocal Ability 40pts.

Stage Presence 40pts.

Song Selection 20pts.

During callbacks, each student will sing the LTHS Alma Mater and/or other songs of Mr. Buntyn's choosing on his/her own part with a group of auditioning students as well as learn a song on the spot. At this audition, the director is listening for a group blend and are looking for a group that looks and sounds appropriate together. Members of the group will be held to the highest standards of excellence and attendance at rehearsals will be treated as attendance of a concert.

Uniforms

Women: Black choir dress issued by LTHS Choir, BLACK dress shoes (closed toe)

Men: Tux, tux shirt, tie, and vest issued

The uniforms will be worn at most concerts and all competitions. Choir uniforms will be due back to the choir department prior to May 3, 2019 (right after spring contest). If a student is out of uniform at a performance, he/she will not be allowed to sing and a performance grade of "zero" will be assigned. If a student needs another size uniform, it is their responsibility to notify the directors at least one week in advance of a performance. We will not address uniform issues the day of the concert. Those students not returning uniforms at the end of the year will be placed on the Hold List until they are returned; graduating seniors will be blocked from graduation. Girls will need their dresses cleaned at least once during the school year and any dress/tux with strong, discernable, body odor or stains will be considered damaged and a fine will be assessed.

DRESSES/PANTS NEED TO BE HEMMED APPROPRIATELY. DO NOT LET SEAMSTRESSES/ TAILORS CUT ANY MATERIAL FROM UNIFORM!

Facilities

Lebanon Trail High School is a brand new and in pristine condition. We will work to keep the school, especially the Arts facilities in that condition. We will use trash cans for trash and all food. Absolutely no food or drinks (other than bottled water) may be on the choir risers or in the auditorium at any time. Frisco ISD has given us the finest facilities in the district and we honor that commitment to our program by treating the rooms and equipment with respect.

Music

Each student will be issued a numbered folder and sheet music. This music is our textbook and students will be responsible for lost and/or damaged music. Remember that having music is also criterion for the rehearsal performance grade. If you can't find your lost music, you will be responsible for the cost of replacing it. Treat your music with respect...do not roll it up, tear it,

bend it backwards, fold it into origami art, or light any part or all of it on fire. Only mark in music in pencil and, though your artistic skills may be wonderful, refrain from doodling on your music.

Choir Trip

Detail for this trip will be presented later in the year. Additional travel opportunities may present themselves through community groups. As opportunities come up we will keep you informed.

Music Enrichment Lessons

Music Enrichment Lessons are offered to all interested choir students. A payment of \$21.00 per lesson should be paid to the ME teacher on a monthly basis. (Four lessons a month @ 21.00 per = \$84.00) ME lessons are an integral part of our choral program and are highly recommended for any student desiring to excel. Every student can benefit greatly from this one-on-one instruction.
